



BIOGRAPHY:

Physical Rocket started out with all four members meeting at a party in September 1997. All members had engagements in other bands at the time but they were no strangers to each other. Six months earlier Jonas Asplund and Peter Karbelius had a gig in Stockholm with their band "Message to love" that the drummer could not attend, what to do? Cancel was no option! They got in contact with Svante Lindquist who played drums with another local coverband in Åkersberga called "Snakeskin Cowboys", whose leadsinger was Eva Rönnqvist, and he came to the rescue. This brief collaboration came to be the beginning of something new.

During the party the future members of Physical Rocket got to talk and ended up sitting in a corner playing guitars and singing. A week later they got together jamming just for fun and after a magic hour in the rehearsal studio they knew that what only had been emotions at the party now really had come in place. The band was formed and a repertoire of favorite songs ranging from Led zeppelin, Jimi Hendrix, Cream, Black Sabbath, Motörhead and others was made. With a bunch of songs and a name the four members was now ready to perform in front of a crowd. Several gigs was made playing covers but after a while original songs started to appear, it was time to record.

The band went into "studioovett", a studio owned and runned by Ove Noring who's a friend of the band, in March 1999 and the CD "Physical Rocket" consisting of six self-penned songs was released in December. More live performances was made and the repertoire came to include more and more of own material as the members all contributed with ideas.

In November 2000 the time had come to do another recording and the band returned to the studio where they made their first recordings. This time the result came to be the album titled "Rising Is My Trend". The CD was released on the label "Trapdoor Records" on May 5:th 2001.

A year later in May 2002 Physical Rocket recorded two songs, "Steal Me" and "If You Want It All Right", that ended up on a promo CD.

In 2003 Physical Rocket did one to two shows a month and it looked as things started to happen for the band but then disaster struck. On October 2:nd Svante Lindquist past away after a tragic accident. The band was devastated, they had lost their best friend...

The decision to continue playing together as Physical Rocket was made and the search for a new drummer started. By a friend they were introduced to Jocke Troëng and in December 2003 they got together for the first time in the rehearsal studio and it all turned out very well. The search was over.

On February 29:th 2004 Physical Rocket did their first gig with Jocke behind the drums at Pub Anchor in Stockholm.

In May/June 2004 the band once again returns to record at "studioovett". Three songs are recorded for a demo titled "Let It Roll Again!".

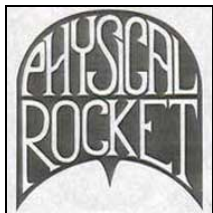

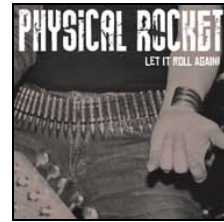
